INCLUDED IN PRICE: 1) Round trip airfare per brochure, deluxe motor coaches, Superior First Class hotels, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast, light lunch & dinner daily on land & while on cruise in Greece & Turkey; 2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$678 USD** comprised of **\$347.60** for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person); 3) Gratuities of **\$175** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on cruise ship, shore excursions to Patmos & Ephesus, Port fees of **\$60**.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Not included in your package are passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports & train stations, Group Travel Protection premiums, excess baggage fees, and all other items not specifically mentioned. Any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of **\$500 per person is required at time of registration**. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (**credit cards are not accepted for final payment**), including optional group insurance premium if applicable, and is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. There may be a late fee of \$195 for all payments or new registrations received **75-60 days prior to departure**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is 19-15 travelers a \$150 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by **imagine Tours and Travel, LLC** (hereafter referred to as **imagine**) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited. **imagine** reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room).

When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While **imagine** will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a single room supplement charge: \$895 for Greece itinerary; additional \$395 for Rome Extension itinerary (total of \$1290 for entire trip).

ITINERARY and CHANGES: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, **imagine** reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to **imagine** no later than 75-days prior to departure. All tours are final at 60-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.

AIRLINE TICKETS: In order to keep prices low, **imagine does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination**. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not **imagine**. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once printed. Air transportation to/ from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. **imagine** is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation.

VISAS: Applicable visas will be obtained by **imagine** for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. **imagine** is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

FLIGHT TIMES: All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. **imagine** is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. 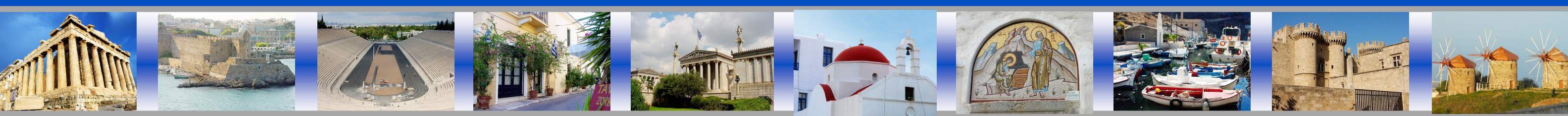

Day 1 - Sunday, September 21: Depart USA for Greece

Embark upon your journey to the lands of ancient treasures and Christian history with an overnight flight to Thessaloniki. Prepare yourself for a life-changing experience. Get some rest on the flight. Tomorrow you will be walking where the apostle Paul walked!

Day 2 - Monday, September 22: Thessaloniki arrival

Arrive in Thessaloniki, the city where Paul was received by Jason. Paul was preaching the Word of God here, until he was rushed out of the city. You will transfer to your hotel for check-in and dinner.

Day 3 - Tuesday, September 23: Philippi / Kavala

We will follow the route of the Via Egnatia and visit, like Paul and his companions, the area of Amphipolis, to see the famous funerary Lion of Amphipolis. Then we travel onto Philippi. There, you visit the Baptistry of Lydia near the river, where Paul baptized her. Lydia was the first convert of Paul on European soil and the conversion of the jailer followed. Also, visit the ruins of the Forum of Philippi, the Christian Basilicas, the “Prison of Paul” and the Theater. Drive to Kavala (Neapolis), Paul’s first step in bringing the Gospel to present day Europe. A picturesque port. View the Byzantine Castle and the Roman Aqueduct. Return to Thessaloniki for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 - Wednesday, September 24: Thessaloniki

In the morning, drive in Thessaloniki to see the landmark of the city, the White Tower, the Walls of the Byzantine Acropolis, the Roman Arch of Galerius and the Rotonda. Visit two of the city’s oldest and most admired Christian churches, the Basilicas of St. Demetrius and St. Sophia (Divine Wisdom). A stop will be made in Berea to view the Bema surrounded by newly placed mosaics of Paul and the plaque of scripture regarding the "more noble" church. We will continue to Kalambaka for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 - Thursday, September 25: Kalambaka

This morning you see the world famous Byzantine monasteries that are perched precariously on summits of gray rock pinnacles of varied and beautiful shapes. Their history goes back to the 14th century when the monks sought refuge in the cliff-side caves, then fled higher to build the original wooden shelters, which were later transformed into monasteries. Continue to Athens for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - Friday, September 26: Start our 3-Day Greek Isles Cruise

We sail this morning from Athens to the quaint isle of Mykonos, called the island of windmills. Experience the waterfront lined with shops and cafes and then stroll the charming walkways through a maze of white-washed buildings before returning to the ship for dinner and evening activities.

Day 7 - Saturday, September 27: Kusadasi, Patmos

In the morning you will arrive in Kusadasi, Turkey, and drive to Ephesus, where Paul spent three years during his ministry. The impressive remains of Ephesus include the Agora, the Theater, the Stadium, the Library of Celsius, the ruins of the Temple of Diana (one of the “Seven Wonders of the Ancient World”) and many more. Later, you will sail for the island of Patmos, where you will visit the Monastery of St. John, on one of the island’s highest points. From there, you will walk down to the Grotto of the Apocalypse, the site of the apocalyptic Revelations of St. John the Divine *(Included: shore excursions to Ephesus & Patmos).*

Day 8 -Sunday, September 28: Crete & Santorini

In the morning arrive at Heraklion, Crete *(this shore excursions is not included)*, where you can choose to visit the Minoan Palace of Knossos, home to king Minos and his legendary beast, the Minotaur. In the Archaeological Museum of Heraklion you can find the unbelievable works of art (pieces of sculpture and pottery, jewelry, arms, frescoes), that have been found in a number of Minoan sites all over Crete. Then, sail north to the isle of Santorini *(this shore excursions is not included)*, the most breathtaking of all the Greek islands. The exquisite whitewashed villages, including the town of Fira, or Thira, cling to volcanic cliffs, accessible by cable-car, or mule.

Day 9 - Monday, September 29: Athens and Corinth

In the morning, admire the architectural miracles of ancient Athens, as you follow your guide to the world-renowned Acropolis, to see the Propylea, the Erechtheum and the Parthenon. Visit Mars Hill, where Paul delivered his ingenious speech on the “Unknown God”. View the Agora, the ancient center of the economic and public life of the city, where Paul preached to the skeptical Athenians. During the bus tour, you see Constitution Square with the

House of Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Temple of Zeus, the Old Olympic Stadium and the Neoclassical Buildings of Athens. Then you continue your trip to Ancient Corinth. This is the once glorious city near the Isthmus, where Paul met Aquilla and Priscilla and spent a year and a half preaching the Word of God. You visit the Archaeological Museum, the Forum, the Temples and the famous Bema, where Paul stood before Gallio, accused by the Jews of Corinth. Then, we drive to Cenchreae, the little harbor from which Paul sailed back to Asia, thus ending his second missionary journey. Dinner and overnight in Athens.

Those continuing onto the Rome extension will say their good-byes and transfer to Athens Airport for their late afternoon/early evening flight to Rome. Upon arrival into Rome, we meet our Italian representative who helps assist us to our hotel for our late dinner and overnight in Rome.

Day 10 - Tuesday, September 30: Athens, Return back to USA

Morning transfer to Athens Airport for our return flight back to the USA.

Day 10 - Tuesday, September 30: Rome, Pompeii, Rome

After breakfast, we meet our guide and board our bus as we travel the next two plus hour scenic drive for Pompeii, to visit the spectacular ruins of Pompeii, which were covered by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in 79 AD. The city remained buried and undiscovered for almost 1500 years until excavation began in 1748. These excavations continue today and provide insight into life during the Roman Empire. We make our way to Rome in time for dinner and overnight.

Day 11 - Wednesday, October 1: Rome, Vatican & Sistine Chapel, Coliseum, Trevi Fountain, Forum

Our first visit will be to the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel, the celebrated Chapel of the Popes and the venue of the Conclaves for Papal elections. It is one of the most splendid masterpieces in the history of world art and is well known around the world for its magnificent ceiling, beautifully decorated by Michelangelo. From here, your next visit will be to the Basilica of St. Peter, the largest church in the world, which overlooks the enormous Piazza San Pietro. We then start our sightseeing of the eternal city. Driving through the main streets of Rome, you will marvel at the monuments of this great capital. Visit the Colosseum, which symbolizes the eternity of the Roman civilization, the Forum and the Piazza Venezia, dominated by the imposing monument to Vittorio Emanuel II. Before we return to our hotel, we stop near the Fontana di Trevi, here, following tradition by tossing a coin into the fountain, promising the return to Rome. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

Day 12 - Thursday, October 2: Rome, Catacombs, St. John Lateran, Basilica of St. Paul, St. Peter in Chains

Today we enjoy our sightseeing tour to include a special visit to the Catacombs where we will explore tunnels and see the carvings on the walls from early Christians. From here we continue for a visit to St. John Lateran, visit the “Sacred Steps” (as a monk, Martin Luther climbed these steps on his knees, trying to merit forgiveness). Afterwards we make a special visit to St. Paul’s Church where tradition believes the Apostle Paul is buried. We conclude our day with a stop to see the Forum with visit and St. Peter in Chains. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

Day 13 - Friday, October 3: Rome, USA

Morning transfer to Rome Airport for return flight back to the US. Fly back home with a new insight into Paul’s life and teaching.
